

Accommodation - Tiverton Hotel (3*)



The Tiverton Hotel, located on the outskirts of Tiverton town centre, has spacious en suite bedrooms, equipped with TV, hair dryer, tea & coffee making facilities, iron & ironing board and free Wi-Fi. A full English breakfast and 3 course table d'hote dinner with a minimum of 3 choices per course plus tea/coffee are included. Additionally, a cream tea is served on arrival. Meals are taken in the Gallery Restaurant and there is also a large bar area. The lift does not serve the bedrooms, but half of the rooms are located on the ground floor. There is level access to the hotel and all public areas.

Monday 22 June - Travel with en route stop in Wells

We depart Brighton and travel to Tiverton with a stop in the delightful Cathedral city of Wells. The magnificent gothic Cathedral dominates the town but also worth a visit are the moated Bishops Palace and gardens where the springs (or wells) originate from, which gave the city its name.

Tuesday 23 June - Horse Drawn Barge Trip on Tiverton Canal

This morning we explore the historic town of Tiverton, home to a 12th century Castle, the award-winning Tiverton Museum of Mid Devon Life and a historic Pannier Market. After lunch, we step back in time and enjoy a scenic trip on the Great Western Canal by horse drawn barge.

Wednesday 24 June – Killerton

Our destination today is Killerton, one of Devon's great country estates. This elegant Georgian house is set in acres of historic parkland and beautiful landscape gardens. Killerton house is also home to the National Trust's biggest fashion collection, with more than 20,000 items of historic clothing and accessories.

Friday 26 June – Stourhead

This morning, we check out of the hotel and depart for Stourhead, an 18th century landscape garden and Palladian mansion housing an extensive gallery of art. The gardens have magnificent lake and grottoes, a collection of rare and exotic plants and trees, and even Roman-style temples. Following our visit, we continue our journey home.

Thursday 25 June–Sidmouth & Seaton

Today we travel to the two beautiful coastal towns of Sidmouth & Seaton on the stunning Jurassic coast. Sidmouth is dominated by vivid red sandstone cliffs with a lovely promenade and beautiful beach. Seaton overlooks Lyme Bay and is also home to the Seaton Tramway, a heritage tram running through the Exe Estuary (tram ride not included).
